## English

This term our focus genre is both Procedure and Narrative. Students will learn how to plan, write, rehearse and then present their spoken procedure to other students. They will take on the role of a character from the novel *Fantastic Mr Fox* by Roald Dahl.

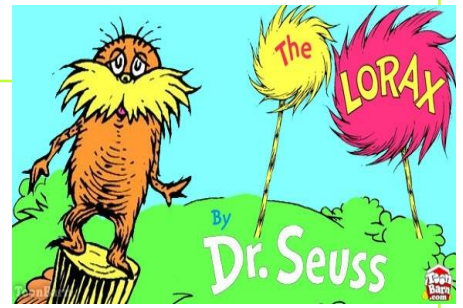
We will also be studying Dreamtime stories and traditional tales from different countries.

The children will learn that a simple narrative begins with an orientation where the characters and setting are introduced. Narratives have a complication, which includes the problem and different events.

## Maths

Once again, this term we are focusing on numbers to 10 000. We will be reviewing place value, along with addition and subtraction involving regrouping and trading. Reading and understanding time is reviewed - concentrating on telling time in five-minute intervals.

Multiplication facts will continue to be revised - 2x,



Then a resolution wraps up the story. Students will also re-write the story, *The Lorax*, from another character's perspective.

The students will continue with Words Their Way spelling. They are grouped according to the particular spelling feature that they find difficult.

Reading is a school wide focus and is such an important key to learning. Each class spends at least 3 hours per week specifically improving reading fluency and comprehension.
