## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving A – C in English to 80% and A&B to 40%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A – C in Mathematics to 85% and A&B to 50%
- Support successful pre-prep transition
- Support oral language and early literacy development in the Early Years

## Our initiatives include

- Develop collaborative data inquiry processes through PLCs (to build teacher capacity to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and differentiate effectively)
- Delivering structured and explicit literacy lessons focussed on improving student outcomes for every student through the enhancement team three times per week consisting of: Enhancement Teacher, Class Teacher and Teacher Aides
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching reading through 7 PLCs/Term
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching number through 2 PLCs/Term
- Strengthening transitions through community access to developmentally appropriate Early Years resources
