Windaroo State School will receive

\$361,005*

This funding will be used to:

- Increase the percentage of students achieving A – C in English to 85%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A or B in English to 40%
- Maintain U2B Reading for Year 3 at or above 50%
- Lift U2B reading for Year 5 to 40%
- Support introduction of Digital Technologies curriculum

Our initiatives include:

- Embed Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) for every domain, creating time to meet and support professional learning
- Develop collaborative data inquiry processes (to build teacher capacity to interpret data, identify and scale up effective teaching practices and differentiate effectively)
- Delivering structured and explicit literacy lessons focussed on resolving a problem of practice through enhancement processes three times per week for every student through the enhancement team consisting of: Leader of Learning, Enhancement Teacher, two Class Teachers and two Teacher Aides working across two year levels
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching reading
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning
- Use of Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 and Literacy Continuum across the school to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress
- Allocate TRS to support year level planning and teacher talks with Leadership team
